Findings from group work, ambitions and status. Here we will provide feedback and plan for support, and establish a springboard that will lift the team.

3) Ongoing support process

At least 4-5 teams will be make a concept ready for testing in a pilot project in real life. By connecting the teams to emerging market networks, we providing support with fundraising for product development and travelling and help finding new team members with relevant competences.
